



Memo / Competition Information

Head to Head Diving October 28-30 2016

Dear Friends,

Listed below is useful information you need to know before the diving competition Head to Head Diving in Stockholm (Alphabetic order).

Awards:

Victory ceremony will be held at the end of each event. Medals and special prizes will be presented to the first, second and third of each event. We will ask the coach of the winner to present the prizes. Prizes can be picked up at the HEAD sales center in the corridor of the diving pool.

Bags:

All divers and coaches are to keep their bags in the dry land area or next to the spectator stands. No bags allowed on the secretariat side of the pool or on the spectator stands!

Changing rooms:

Bring your own padlock. You can buy one at the reception if you don't have one. Girls: Room 5-6, Boys: Room 7-9.

Cafeteria:

The Cafeteria is located at the lower public entrance to Eriksdalsbadet. This is where all meals will be served, use your lunch tickets! They also serve sandwiches, hot and cold drinks and snacks to purchase.

Coffee and snacks for coaches and judges:

Will be served on the second floor in the diving pool.

NOTE! Important

Diving sheets:

The competition will use Diverecorder and the dive sheets shall be posted online by the participator/coaches no later than **Monday the 24 October**. Changes can be made until 18:00 the day before the specific event. <http://www.diverecorder.co.uk>

NOTE!

It's very important that you choose the correct event for each diver! As wrongfully entered sheets takes a lot of time from the competition secretariat **we will charge each team 150 skr/15 euro** for each diver that is entered in wrong event!

Dry land area:

Is only to be used as warm-up facility! No playing or jumping on the trampoline/diving board! Divers can't enter the Dry land area without their coaches. Coaches are responsible for the divers in their team!

Emergency Exits:

It is absolutely forbidden to enter or leave the building by the Emergency Exits. The Emergency Exits should only be used in case of danger. Unauthorized use will trigger the alarm. Please note that the big doors behind the diving pool are also an emergency exit, and must not be used.

Entrance to the pool:

On Thursday 27 Oct you will enter the pool through the main entrance of the pool, through the pools pay desk. All entrance to the pool **during competition days** is through the doors next to the dry land area on the back side of the pool.

**Events:**

NOTE! Both the D-girls and C-girls events on springboard will be separated in to two events, one for the oldest and one for the younger girls. The two events will compete simultaneously on 1m and 3m. Make sure that you notice this in the program/Event order and when you submit your dive sheets.

Food:

Lunch and Dinner will be served in the pool restaurant/cafeteria for those of you who ordered meals. Lunch time 11.30-13.30 (Friday, Saturday and Sunday) and dinner time 18.00-20.00 (Friday and Saturday). Use your lunch tickets.

Info box:

Every participating team has a mailbox at the competition office. Please check daily for information, lunch tickets etc.

Judges:

All judges shall be dressed in a white t-shirt, you need to bring your own. A judge schedule will be sent to you and posted on the wall of the pool. Please be prepared to judge when you are listed to!

Lost items:

All lost items will be collected after each day and placed in a lost items container.

Opening Ceremony:

Please note that there will be an Opening Ceremony! It will take place Saturday 28 Oct at 17.10. Please have two divers from each team prepared in team uniforms at 16.05 in the corridor to the diving pool.

Payment:

All cost for each team (entry fees and meals etc.) should be paid before the competition starts. Each team will get an invoice/payment information with the total competition fee. Masters divers who aren't included in the club invoice, pay their entry fee at the pool before their events!

Practice:

Following hours the boards and platform will be open for practice:

Thursday 27 oct: 15.00 – 20.00

Friday 28 oct: 08.00 – 11.00

Saturday 24 oct: 07.00 – 08.30

Sunday 25 oct: 07.00 – 08.30.

NOTE! Between events and 20 min prior to competition start each morning ONLY divers' competing in the following event is allowed on each board.

Results:

All results will be posted on the wall in the corridor to the diving pool. Results will also be posted on the website after the competition and on Diverecorder.

Start lists/Dive sheets:

Will be posted behind each competition platform prior to the competition. Please check closely and report all errors to the competition secretariat.
